



# Crochet Flower Scarf

WC1657



Scarf measures 7" x 42".

**AUNT LYDIA'S® "Fashion Crochet Thread"**, Size 3:  
2 Balls 871 Plum **A** and 1 ball each 264 Lime **B**, 625 Sage **C**, 226 Natural **D** and 423 Maize **E**.

OR

**J&P COATS® Royale™ "Fashion Crochet Thread"**, Size 3:  
2 Balls 871 Plum **A** and 1 ball each 264 Lime **B**, 625 Sage **C**, 226 Natural **D** and 423 Maize **E**.

**Crochet Hook:** 3.5mm [US E-4].

Yarn needle; 30 gold rocaille beads; sewing needle and thread.

**GAUGE:** 6 ch-5 spaces = 4"; 6 rows = 3" in pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## SCARF

With **A**, ch 48.

**Row 1 (Right Side):** Sc in 8th ch from hook, \* ch 5, skip next 3 ch, sc in next ch; repeat from \* across; turn.

**Row 2:** \* Ch 5, sc in space; repeat from \* across; turn.

Repeat Row 2 for pattern until scarf measures 42" long. Fasten off.

**SMALL FLOWER** (Make 8 with **B**, 10 with **C** and 4 with **CD**): Leaving a 6" end, ch 3; join with a slip st to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** \* Ch 1, [2 hdc, ch 1, slip st] 5 times all in ring – 5 petals made. Fasten off leaving a 6" end; pull end through center to back and tie to beginning end.

**LARGE FLOWER** (Make 4 with **D** and 4 with **E**): Leaving a 6" end, ch 3; join with a slip st to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** \* Ch 2, [2 hdc, ch 2, slip st] 5 times all in ring – 5 petals made. Fasten off leaving a 6" end; pull end through center to back and tie to beginning end.

**FINISHING:** Referring to photo, arrange flowers on the right side of each scarf end. To attach each flower, bring thread ends to wrong side and tie around a ch-5 space to secure; weave in ends. Using needle and sewing thread, sew a bead to center of each flower.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** **A, B, C**, etc. = color A, B, C, etc.;  
**ch** = chain; **hdc** = half double crochet; **mm** = millimeters;  
**rnd** = round; **sc** = single crochet; **st** = stitch; \* = repeat  
whatever follows the \* as indicated; [ ] = work directions in  
brackets the number of times specified.
