Row 5: Ch 1, sc in first 8 sc, *FPdc around each of next 2 dc **two rows below**, skip next 2 sc **on last row**, sc in next 2 sc **on last row**, repeat from *, ending with sc in last 6 sc. Turn. (22 sc and 8 FPdc)

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in first 8 sc, *FPdc around each of next 2 FPdc **two rows below**, skip next 2 sc **on last row**, sc in next 2 sc **on last row**, repeat from *, ending with sc in last 6 sc. Turn.

Row 9: Ch 1, sc in first 7 sc, FPdc around each of the next 2 FPdc **two rows below**, skip 2 sc **on last row** behind FPdc, sc in next 4 sc **on last row**, FPdc around each of the next 4 FPdc **two rows below**, skip 4 sc **on last row** behind FPdc, sc in next 4 sc **on last row**, FPdc around each of the next 2 Fpdc **two rows below**, skip 2 sc **on last row** behind FPdc, sc in last 7 sc. Turn.

Row 11: Ch 1, sc in first 7 sc, FPdc around each of the next 2 FPdc **two rows below**, skip 2 sc **on last row** behind FPdc, sc in next 4 sc **on last row**, skip next 2 FPdc **two rows below**, FPdc around third and fourth FPdc **two rows below**, FPdc around first and then second skipped FPdc **two rows below** (Cable made), skip 4 sc **on last row** behind FPdc, sc in next 4 sc **on last row**, FPdc around each of the next 2 FPdc **two rows below**, skip 2 sc **on last row** behind FPdc, sc in last 7 sc. Turn.

LC1245, DOUBLE DELIGHT Beginner

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in same ch as joining and in next dc, * sc in sp, sc in 2 tr, **5 sc** in ch-3 sp, sc in 2 tr, sc in sp, sc in 2 dc, 5 sc in ch-5 sp, sc in sc, 5 sc in ch-5 sp **, sc in 2 dc; rep from * around, end at **; join to first sc. Fasten off.

LC1478, CROCHET BLACK LACE BOLERO Intermediate

Shape Cap-First Row: Sl st across first 5 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, ch 1, work in pat to last 4 sts; turn. [Dec 2 sts each end of next row. Work 1 row even.] twice. Work 3 more rows even. [Rep First Row. Work 1 row even.] 3 4 times – 9 (13, 17) sts. Fasten off.

Shape Armhole and Front Slope: Omit 4 sts at arm edge by either sl st across first 5 OR working to last 4 sts and turning as before – 29 (33, 37) sts. Dec 2 sts at each end of next row, then every 4th row 3 times – 13 (17, 21) sts. [Now dec 2 sts at 'front opening' end ONLY on 4th row from previous dec] twice† – 9 (13, 17) sts. Work even in pat until front is same length as back. Fasten off.

LC1487, CROCHET BOLERO Easy

LEFT FRONT

Rep Row 3 above. Rep Row 4 above 6 (8, 10) times.

Next Row-Shape Front (Wrong Side): Ch 3, skip first dc, dc in each dc to last st; 2 dc in top of ch-3; turn – 67 (71, 79) sts.

Next Row: Ch 3, dc in first dc, dc in each dc across and in top of ch-3; turn – 68 (72, 80) sts. FASTEN OFF.

With wrong side facing, skip first 42 (42, 46) sts of sleeve, attach yarn in next st; ch 3, dc in each dc to last st; 2 dc in top of ch-3; turn – 27 (31, 35) sts.

** Continue to increase 1 st at center front edge on next 7 rows, end right side row – 34 (38, 42) sts. Rep Eyelet Row 2 and Row 3 same as for Back. Fasten off. **

RIGHT FRONT

Rep Row 3 above. Rep Row 4 above 6 (8, 10) times.

Next Row-Shape Front (Wrong Side): Ch 3, dc in first dc, dc in each dc across and in top of ch-3; turn – 67 (71, 79) sts.

Next Row: Ch 3, skip first dc, dc in each dc to last st; 2 dc in top of ch-3; turn – 68 (72, 80) sts.

Next Row: Ch 3, dc in first dc, dc in next 25 (29, 33) dc; TURN – 27 (31, 35) sts. Rep from ** to ** same as Left Front.

LC1554, MANTILLA DOILY Intermediate

Size 10 Thread: 400 Yards **Black**.

LC1717, VINTAGE PINAPPLE DOILY Intermediate

Row 11: (ch 3, dc, ch 2, 2 dc) all in same space.

LM0217, KNIT BOLERO Intermediate

Bolero Edging: Sew side seams. With larger needle, cast on 30 (30, 40, 40) sts for tie, then with right side facing, pick up and K140 (148, 156, 164) sts along bottom edge of bolero, cast on 30 (30, 40, 40) sts for tie – 200 (208, 236, 244) sts.

Next Row: K37 (32, 37, 32) sts, PM, P to last 37 (32, 37, 32) sts, PM, K to end.

LC1768 PETAL SCARF

EASY

Round 2: Ch 2, hdc in same st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 5 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 4 sts, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 4 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 4 sts, 2 hdc in last st, slip st to top of beginning ch.

Round 3: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 6 st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 6 hdc, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 6 st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 5 st, 2 hdc in next st, ~~hdc in next st~~, slip st to top of beginning ch.

Row 4: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 3 sts.

LC2181 Twisty Lace Scarf

Row 2: Ch 2, skip first space, (~~C1~~ dc, ch 2; ch 3, slip st in 3rd ch from hook – picot made; ch 2, ~~C1~~ dc) all in next space, ch 1, * skip next space, (~~C1~~ dc, ch 2, picot, ch 2, dc ~~C1~~) all in next space **, ch 1; repeat from * to last space, end at **; ch 2, slip st in 3rd ch of ch-4. Fasten off.

LM0227, TULIP THROW

Easy

BORDER

Rnd 1: With right side facing, attach CA in upper right hand corner; ch 1, * work an odd number of sc evenly across to next corner, work 3 sc in corner; rep from * around taking care to keep work flat; join with a sl st in first sc.

LM0241, KNIT TEXTURES SCARF

Intermediate

GAUGE: 18 sts = 3 1/4"; 18 rows = 4" in Wandering Cable & Bobble Panel with 2 strands of yarn. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.**

Scarf

With 2 strands of yarn held together as one, cast on 34 sts.

LM0248, MINI CROCHET CAPELET

Easy

Row 2: Ch 3, *(dc, ch 1, dc) all in next ch-2 sp; rep from * to last sc; dc in last sc; turn.

LM0263, KNIT BABY PULLOVER

Easy

3 (4, 4, 4) 1/2" buttons

Button Band: With right side facing, K across 18 (19, 20, 20) sts on right back holder, pick up and K4 sts across neckband – 22 (23, 24, 24) sts. Work in Moss st for 6 rows. Bind off.

Buttonhole Band: With right side facing, pick up and K4 sts across neckband, K across 18 (19, 20, 20) sts on right front holder – 22 (23, 24, 24) sts. Work in Moss st for 2 rows. Mark for 3 (4, 4, 4) evenly spaced buttonholes.

Next Row: [Work pat to marker, work 2 sts tog, yo] 3 (4, 4, 4) times, work pat to end. Work 3 rows of Moss st. Bind off.

LM0267, KNIT CABLE & RIB SWEATER

Intermediate

BACK: Cast on 100 (108, 116, 132, 140) sts. (** removed)

Row 15: Work to marker, P1, C5R, C5L, P2, C5R, C5L, P1, work to end.

Shape Armholes: Keeping continuity of pat, bind off 6 (7, 8, 11, 12) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st each end of every row until 86 (92, 98, 104, 110) sts rem, then every right side row until 80 (84, 88, 94, 98) sts rem. (** removed)

Work even in pat until 21 (21 1/2, 22, 22 1/2, 23)" from beg, end wrong side row.

Shape Shoulders: Bind off 7 (7, 7, 8, 9) sts at beg of next 4 rows, then 6 (6, 8, 9, 9) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Put rem 40 (44, 44, 44, 44) sts on a holder.

FRONT: Work same as Back until 3 (3, 3 1/2, 3 1/2, 4)" less than Back to shoulder shaping

FINISHING

Next Row: P5 (3, 3, 3, 3), [K4, P4] 2 (3, 3, 3, 3) times, work in pat across 24 sts, P4, [K4, P4] 3 (4, 4, 4, 4) times, work in pat across 24 sts, P4, K5 (4, 4, 4, 4), P0 (3, 3, 3, 3).

LM0285 SIDE TO SIDE KNIT CARDIGAN

Easy

Shape second Armhole and Shoulder for Right Front:

With WS facing dec 2 sts at beg of next row than every other row for 4 (4, 5, 5) times – 53 (55, 57, 59) sts. Work next 6 (8, 10, 12) rows even.

Sleeves (make 2):

Incr 1 st at each end of work on next row, than every 4th row for 5 times more – 59 (61, 63, 65) sts.

Bottom Band:

Row 4: (RS): K1 (K4, K1, K3) Work in Pattern A over next 143 (143, 154, 154) sts 13 (13, 14, 14) times, K2, (K5, K2, K5).

LM0287, KNIT CROPPED CARDIGAN

Intermediate

FINISHING

Collar: Sew shoulder seams. With **wrong** side facing and circular needle, beg at marker on Left Front at beg of front slope shaping, pick up and K64 (66, 70, 72) sts up left front to shoulder seam, **55** (57, 59, 61) sts across back to next shoulder seam, **64** (66, 70, 72) sts down right front to marker at beg of Right Front slope shaping – 183 (189, 199, 205) sts.

LT1514, CROCHET TODDLER SET

Intermediate

Shape Neck/Shoulder: Keeping continuity of pat, omit (sl st across first or leave remaining sts unworked) 4 (4, 4, 6) sts at neck edge on next row, then **dec 1 st** at neck edge every other row 4 times – 20 (22, 24, 24) sts. Work even until Front measures same as Back to shoulder. Fasten off.

LW1336, GENTLE RIPPLE

Intermediate

Row 2: Ch 2, dc in next sc, [dc2tog] twice, * ch 1, [puff st in next sc, ch 1] 5 times ******, [dc2tog] 6 times; rep from * to last 6 sc, end at ******; [dc2tog] 3 times; turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each dc and ch-1 sp across; **sc** in top of ch-3 changing to **CC**. Cut **CB**.

LW1490, CROCHET TOTE AND SCARF

Rnd 3: Ch 3, dc in each dc around; join.

Rnd 4: Rep Rnd 2.

Rnd 5: Sl st in **top of dc of Row 3**, ch 3, * sl st in next dc, ch 5; rep from * around; join. Fasten off.

Rnd 5: With **CB** ch 3, 2 dc in same sc as joining, skip next sc, * 3 dc in next sc, skip next sc; rep from * around; join – **60 54** sts. Fasten off.

Intermediate

Materials:

RED HEART® "Super Saver®": **3** Skeins 316 Soft White **CA**, **4** skeins 885 Delft Blue **CB**, **6** skeins 310 Monet Print **CC**.

LW1619 SELF STRIPING KNIT SOCKS

Intermediate

Shape Toe-Rnd 1: K to last 3 sts on first needle, K2tog, K1; on 2nd needle, K1, slip 1, **K1**, pssso, K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1; on 3rd needle, K1, slip 1, K1, pssso, K to end.

LW1627, CROCHET BABY MITER BLANKET

Easy

SQUARE

Row 3: ...sc in 3rd ch of ch-4, changing to CA in last stitch; turn – 31 sts.

Row 6: Ch 1, [sc in dc, sc in space] 6 times, sc3tog, [sc in space, sc in dc] 5 times, sc in next space, sc in 3rd ch of ch-4, changing to CB in last stitch; turn – 25 sts.

Row 9: Ch 1, sc in first 8 dc, sc3tog, sc in last 7 dc, sc in top of ch, changing to CC in last stitch; turn – 17 sts.

Row 12: Ch 1, sc in first 5 dc, sc3tog, sc in last 4 dc, sc in top of ch, changing to CA in last stitch; turn – 11 sts.

Row 15: Ch 1, sc in first dc, sc3tog, sc in last dc; turn – 3 sts.

BORDER

Row 2: ... ([dc, ch 1] twice, dc) all in middle sc of 3 sc corner, dc in last sc; turn.

Special Abbreviations

Sc3tog = Draw up a loop in next 3 sts, yo and through all 4 loops on hook.

Dc5tog = [Yo, draw up a loop in next st, yo and through 2 loops] 5 times, yo and through all 6 loops on hook.

Change Color in sc: Work to one stitch before color change, draw up a loop in the next stitch, drop the color in use; with next color, yo and through 2 loops on hook.

Correction to Motif 1

Rnd 1: Ch 3, [yo and draw up a lp in ring, yo and draw through 2 lps] twice, yo and draw through all 3 lps on hook – beg CL made; ch 3; * [yo and draw up a lp in ring, yo and draw through 2 lps] 3 times, yo and draw through all 4 lps on hook – CL made; ch 3; rep from * 4 more times; join with a sl st in top of beg CL – 6 CL. Fasten off.

Side Border:

Row 1: Ch 1, 2 sc in first row, [ch 1, sc] in each row to last row, ch 1, 2 sc in last row, turn.

Strip Border:

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, *[work 2 hdc in each corresponding ch-1 space 2 rows below (Row 1 of Side Border) pulling st up to current level] across to last 2 sc, sc in last 2 sc, ch 2, turn to work along short end of Strip, 2 sc in edge of Row 2 of Side Border, 2 sc in edge of Row 1 of Side Border, skip next 2 dc, 2 sc in next ch-3 space, skip next 2 dc, 2 sc in edge of Row 1 of Side Border, 2 sc in edge of Row 2 of Side Border, turn to work along opposite long edge of Strip, ch 2; repeat from *, join with a slip st to beginning sc.

RIGHT SIDE

Row 2: ... skip first st... across to last st; Fpdc around ch-2, turn – 148 sts.

Row 3: Ch 2, skip first st... across to last st; Bpdc around ch-2, turn.

Row 20: Ch 3 (count as dc), skip first st...

Row 21: Ch 3, skip first st...

Row 22: Ch 3 (count as dc), skip first st...

Row 23: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts...

Row 24: Ch 3 (count as dc), skip first st...

Row 25: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sts... sc in next 3 sts...

Row 35: Ch 3, skip first st...

RIGHT FRONT

Row 1: ...repeat from * across to last st; Bpdc around ch-2, turn – 46 sts...

Rows 3, 5 and 7: Slip st in sc, sc in hdc ... – 38 sts including the slip st.

LEFT FRONT

Ch 39. (Note: if you work into the "bumps" on the wrong side of the ch instead of into the front of the ch, you can ch 38 here and ch 4 instead of 5 on Rows 3 and 5.)

Row 1 (WS): Slip st in 2nd ch from hook and in next ch, sc in next ch, hdc in next ch, dc in each of the next 34 ch, turn – 38 sts.

Rows 2 and 4: Ch 2, skip first st, ...to last st before hdc, Fpdc in next st, Bpdc in hdc, Fpdc in sc...

Rows 3 and 5: Ch 5, slip st in 2nd ch from hook and in next ch, sc in next ch, hdc in next ch, Fpdc in next sc, Bpdc in next hdc, *Fpdc in next st, ...

Row 6: Ch 2, skip first st... to last st before hdc, Fpdc in next st, Bpdc in hdc, Fpdc in sc...

LEFT SIDE

Row 45: ...Fpdc in sc, Bpdc in hdc, *Fpdc in next st, Bpdc in next st; repeat from * across; turn.

Row 47: Ch 2, skip first st... across to last st; Bpdc around ch-2, turn.

Row 48: Ch 2, skip first st... across to last st; Fpdc around ch-2, turn.

Row 50: Ch 3 (count as dc), skip first st, dc in next st...

Row 51: Ch 3, skip first st, dc in next st...

Row 52: Ch 3 (count as dc), skip first st...

Row 53(WS): Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts...

Row 54: Ch 3 (count as dc), skip first st...

Row 55: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sts...

Rows 56-59: Repeat Rows 52-55.

Rows 60-61: Ch 1...

Rows 62-63: Repeat Rows 50-51.

Row 64: Ch 1...

Row 65: Ch 3, skip first st, dc in each st, turn.

Row 66: Ch 2, skip first st... across to last st; Fpdc around ch-2, turn.

Round 6: With WS facing, join CC in sp before first 3-dc group; ch 1, picot in sp ** [skip next dc, sc in next dc; (2dc, ch2, 2dc) all in **the same** sp--shell made] twice; skip next dc, sc in next dc, shell in next dc, sc in next dc [shell in next sp, skip next dc, sc in next dc] twice, * picot in next sp; rep from ** to next 3 dc group; rep from * around; join. Fasten off.

Side Edging: With right side facing and working along long edge, join yarn and sc 120 (144, 168) sts evenly spaced along side edge. Fasten off.

Repeat Edging along opposite long edge. Do not fasten off; pivot to work across short edge.

Border: 3 Sc in first st, sc in each st across to last st, 3 sc in last st, pivot to work down long edge, sc in each sc across, pivot to work across next short edge, 3 sc in first st, sc in each st to last st, 3 sc in last st, pivot to work up remaining long edge, sc in each sc across; join with a slip st to first sc. Fasten off.

Rnd 11: In first dc of dc-group, ch 1, * sc in first dc, ch 1, skip next dc, sc in next dc, Fpdc around **next dc**, sc in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc, sc in next dc, Fptr around Fptr 2 rows below; repeat from * around; slip st in first sc to join.

Rnd 13: In first dc of dc-group, ch 1, * sc in first dc, ch 3, skip 1 dc, sc in next dc, Fptr around **the post** st 2 rows below; repeat from * around; slip st in first sc to join.

LW1911 WAVY CROCHET HAT & SCARF **Intermediate**

Hat pattern rewritten.

HAT

Ch 4; join with a slip st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 8 sc in ring; join with a slip st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc around; do NOT join – 16 sc Now work in continuous rnds without joining. Place a marker in first st of rnd and move marker up each rnd. **Rnd 3:** [Inc in next sc, sc in next sc] 8 times – 24 sc.

Rnd 4: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc] 8 times – 32 sc.

Rnd 5: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc] 8 times – 40 sc.

Rnds 6, 8, 10: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 7: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc] 8 times – 48 sc.

Rnd 9: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc] 8 times – 56 sc.

Rnd 11: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc] 8 times – 64 sc.

Rnds 12-22: Sc in each sc around. At end of Rnd 22, join in next sc; TURN.

Rnd 23: ch 1, sc in each sc around; join.

Rnd 24: Ch 1, sc in first sc, * skip 3 sc, 7 dc in next sc, skip 3 sc **, sc in next sc; repeat from * around, end at **; join; TURN.

Rnd 25: Ch 1, * sc in next 3 dc, (sc, ch 2, sc) all in next dc, sc in next 3 dc; repeat from * around; join; TURN.

Rnd 26: Skip sc of joining, slip st in next sc, ch 1, * sc in next 3 sc, (sc, ch 2, sc) all in ch-2 space, sc in next 3 sc; repeat from * around; join. Fasten off.

Weave in ends. Turn up shell edge to form cuff.

Rnd 1: Join **A** in ch 5 space at top right corner, ch 1, 5 sc in same space, *[skip next 2 sts, sc in next st, 3 sc in next ch space, skip next 2 sts, sc in next st, 5 sc in next ch space] 3 times, **5 sc in next ch space; rep from * across ending at ** (left corner), rep from * to ** 2 times, 5 sc in next ch space; rep from * around.

Rnd 2: Join with slip stitch to beg sc, fasten off.

Filler motifs are joined to the ch-3 spaces of the large motifs. At least 4 large motifs must be assembled to form a space where the filler motif is to be joined.

Place markers for raglan shaping-Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in first 7 hdc, * 2 hdc in next hdc placing a marker on last hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc placing a marker on first hdc *, hdc in next 3 hdc, repeat from * to * once, hdc in next 14 hdc, repeat from * to * once, hdc in next 3 hdc, repeat from * to * once, hdc in last 7 hdc; turn – 50 hdc. 8

Markers have been placed. **Note:** Stitches before and including the first marker are for Left Front. Stitches between and including the 2nd and 3rd markers are for Left Sleeve. Stitches between and including the 4th and 5th markers are for Back. Stitches between and including the 6th and 7th markers are for Right Sleeve. Stitches including and following the 8th marker are for Right Front.

Move markers for each subsequent row to increased hdc, as before.

Rows 3-10: Ch 2, * hdc in each hdc to marker, [2 hdc in marked hdc] twice; repeat from * 3 times more; hdc in each hdc to end; turn – 114 hdc at end of Row 10.

Note: In each increase row (Rows 3–10 and Row 12) a total of 8 sts are increased: 1 st in each Front, and 2 sts in each Sleeve and in Back.

Row 11: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc to end of row placing markers in same hdc as previous row; turn.

Row 12: Ch 2, * hdc in each hdc to marker, [2 hdc in marked hdc] twice; repeat from * 3 times more; hdc in each hdc to end; turn.

Sizes 12 and 18 months ONLY: Repeat last 2 rows (1, 2) times more.

All Sizes: 122 (130, 138) hdc. **Note:** At this point, there should be 18 (19, 20) sts in each Front, 25 (27, 29) sts in each Sleeve, and 36 (38, 40) sts in the Back.

Divide Body: For underarms, with right-~~right~~ wrong side facing, join **MC** to marked hdc at end of Right Front, ch 3; join with sl st to first marked hdc at beginning of Back; fasten off. Repeat on opposite underarm, beginning in last marked hdc at end of Back and joining to first marked hdc at beginning of Left Front.

Note: When working the following row, skip the Sleeve sts. The Sleeve sts are left unworked at this time, and will be worked into later.

Row 1 (Right Side): Ch 2, hdc in first 18 (19, 20) hdc (Left Front), hdc in next 3 ch, hdc in next 36 (38, 40) hdc (Back), hdc in next 3 ch, hdc in last 36 (38, 40) 18 (19, 20) hdc (Right Front); join **CC**; turn – 78 (82, 86) hdc.

Row 2: With **CC**, ch 1, sc in first 38 (40, 42) hdc, sc2tog, sc in last 38 (40, 42) hdc; turn – 77 (81, 85) sc.

Row 3 (Eyelet Row): Ch 4, skip first 2 sc, * dc in next sc, ch 1, skip next sc; repeat from * to last sc; dc in last sc; turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in each dc and ch-1 sp across dec 1 (2, 0) sts evenly spaced, ending with sc in 4th and 3rd ch of turning ch; join **MC**; turn – 76 (79, 85) sc.

Row 5: With **MC**, ch 1, sc in first sc, * ch 5, skip next 2 sc, sc in next sc; repeat from * across; turn.

Row 6: Ch 5, * sc in next ch-5 lp, ch 3; repeat from * across ending with sc in last ch-5 lp, ch 2, dc in last sc; turn.

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in first dc, 2 sc in ch-2 sp, * sc in next sc, 3 sc in next ch-3 sp; repeat from * across ending with 2 sc in turning ch, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch; turn.

Row 8: Ch 3, dc in next sc, * ch 1, skip next sc, dc in next 2 sc; repeat from * across; turn.

Row 9: Ch 5, * sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 5; repeat from * across ending with sc in last ch-1 sp, ch 2, skip next dc, dc in top of ch-3; turn.

Repeat Rows 6-9 three times more. Cut **MC**.

Next Row (Right Side): Join **CC** to 3rd ch of ch-5 at beginning of last row; ch 1, sc in same sp, * 3 dc in next sc, sc in next ch-5 lp, ch 3, skip next sc, sc in next ch-5 lp; repeat from * across ending with 3 dc in last sc, sc in last dc. Fasten off.

SLEEVES-Rnd 1: With right side facing, join **MC** to rem lp of center ch at underarm, ch 2, hdc in same sp, hdc in next lp, hdc in next 25 (27, 29) hdc around sleeve, hdc in last lp; join with a sl st to top of ch 2 – 28 (30, 32) hdc.

Next Rnd: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around; join. Repeat last rnd until sleeve measures 3 (3 1/2, 4)" from joining rnd, inc 2 (inc 0, dec 2) sts evenly around last rnd – 30 hdc.

Next Rnd: Ch 3, dc in next hdc, *ch 1, skip next hdc, dc in next 2 hdc; repeat from * to last hdc; ch 1, skip last hdc; join with a sl st to top of ch-3.

Next Rnd: Ch 1, sc in same st as joining, * ch 5, sc in next ch-1 sp; repeat from * around ending with ch 5. Fasten off.

Next Rnd: Join **CC** to any ch-5 lp; ch 1, sc in same lp, * 3 dc in next sc, sc in next lp, ch 3 **, skip next sc, sc in next lp; repeat from * around end at **; join with a sl st to first sc. Fasten off.



Presents Crochet Pillows

Each finished pillow measures 16" x 16".

For Presents Crochet Throw see WT1689.

TLC® "Amoré™": 1 Skein each of two colors desired. Photographed pillows in 3907 Red Velvet, 3105 Light Cream and 3002 Black.

Crochet Hook: 5mm [US H-8].

Notions: 16" x16" pillow form, yarn needle.

GAUGE: 13 sts = 4"; 8 rows = 4" in dc. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**

PILLOW COVER

Ch 48.

Row 1: Dc in 3rd ch from hook (beginning ch-2 counts as first dc), dc in next ch and each ch across – 46 dc.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as first dc here and throughout), turn, skip first dc, dc in next dc and each dc across, working last dc in top of turning ch.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 32"/81.5cm (approx 64 rows total). Fasten off. Fold piece in half, bringing first row up to meet last row. With yarn needle, whipstitch the side seams together, leaving top open. With yarn needle, backstitch along one side edge, across the bottom fold line, and along the other side. Slip pillow form into place and sew the top opening closed with whipstitch and then backstitch.

BOW BODY

Ch 16.

Row 1: Dc in 3rd ch from hook (beginning ch-2 counts as first dc), dc in next ch and each ch across – 7 dc.

Rows 2–28: Ch 2 (counts as first dc here and throughout), turn, sk first dc, dc in next dc and each dc across, working last dc in top of turning ch.

Fasten off leaving a 15" yarn tail. Fold the piece in half, bringing the first row up to meet the last row, to form a tube. Whipstitch the two ends together with the yarn tail. Flatten the tube and weave a 8" piece of yarn through the center stitches and gently pull tight to gather the fabric.

BOW BAND

Ch 9.

Row 1: Dc in 3rd ch from hook (beginning ch-2 counts as first dc), dc in next ch and each ch across – 14 dc.

Rows 2–11: Ch 2 (counts as first dc here and throughout), turn, skip first dc, dc in next dc and each dc across, working last dc in top of turning ch.

Fasten off leaving a 6" yarn tail. Tightly wrap bow band around gathered center of bow body, overlapping the ends of the bow band slightly. Pin in place. With yarn needle and yarn tail, sew bow band around center of bow.

RIBBON (make 2)

Ch 8.

Row 1: Dc in 3rd ch from hook (beginning ch-2 counts as first dc), dc in next ch and each ch across – 6 dc.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as first dc here and throughout), turn, skip first dc, dc in next dc and each dc across, working last dc in top of turning ch.

Repeat Row 2 until ribbon, slightly stretched, measures 16". Fasten off.

FINISHING

Using photograph as a guide sew ribbons to pillow with yarn needle and matching yarn. Sew bow to center of pillow at the point where ribbons cross. Weave in all ends.



TLC® “ Amore™”, Art. E515 available in solid colors – 6oz (170g), 278yd (254m) or multi colors – 4.5oz (127g), 214yd (195m) skeins.

ABBREVIATIONS: **Ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **rnd** = round; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
