# crochet ripple shrug

LT1540

Easy

Designed by Marilyn Coleman.

**Directions are for Small/Medium; changes for Medium/ Large are in parentheses.**

**TLC® "Essentials™":** 4 (4¼) Ounces No. 2675  
**CA,** 3 (3¼) ounces No. 2958 Falling Leaves **CB,** and  
3¼ (4) ounces No. 2919 Barn Red **CC.**

**Crochet Hook:** 5.5mm [US I-9].  
Split stitch markers; yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** One repeat = 2 ¾" across; 8 rows = 4" in  
pat. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook  
to obtain the gauge.**

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS:

**Sc dec** = draw up a lp in each of next 2 sts, yo and  
draw through all 3 lps on hook.

**Dc dec** = [yo and draw up a lp in next st, yo and  
draw through 2 lps] twice, yo and draw through all  
3 lps on hook.

**To Change Color in Sc Dec:** draw up a lp in each  
of last 2 sts, drop color in use, with next color to be  
used yo and draw through all 3 lps on hook.

**SLEEVE (Make 2):** With **CA,** ch 22 (26).

**Row 1 (Right Side):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and  
in each ch across; turn – 21 (25) sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across; turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, skip next sc, \* (2 dc, ch  
2, 2 dc) all in next sc, skip next sc \*\*, 2 sc in next sc,  
skip next sc; rep from \* to last sc, end at \*\*; sc in  
last sc; turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, \* (sc, ch 2, sc) all in  
ch-2 sp \*\*, sc in next 6 sts; rep from \* to last 3 sts,  
end at \*\*; sc in last 3 sts changing to **CB** in last sc;  
turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 2, skip first sc, dc in next 3 sc, \* (dc, ch  
2, dc) all in ch-2 sp, dc in next 2 sc \*\*, [dc dec]  
twice, dc in next 2 sc; rep from \* to last 2 sc, end at  
\*\*; dc dec over last 2 sc; turn.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, sc dec over first 2 sts, sc in next 2 dc,  
\* (sc, ch 2, sc) all in ch-2 sp, sc in next 2 dc \*\*, [sc  
dec] twice, sc in next 2 dc; rep from \* to last 2 dc,  
end at \*\*; sc dec over last 2 dc; turn.

Rep Rows 5 and 6 for pat working 2 more rows  
with **CB,** then in color sequence of 4 rows each of

**CC, CA,** and **CB** until 17 (17½)" from beg. Mark  
each end of last row. Continue in pat and color  
sequence until approximately 25½ (26½)" from beg,  
end by working Row 5.

**Last Row:** Ch 3, skip first st, \* dc in next dc, hdc in  
next 2 dc, sc in ch-2 sp, hdc in next 2 dc, dc in next  
dc \*\*, dc dec; rep from \* to last st, end at \*\*; dc in  
last st. Fasten off leaving a long end for sewing.

**FINISHING:** Sew back seam. Sew sleeve seams to  
markers.

**Body Edging:** With right side facing, join **CA** at a  
seam; ch 1, sc evenly around entire body opening,  
taking care to keep work flat; join with a sl st to first  
sc. Fasten off.

**Cuff-Rnd 1:** With right side facing, attach **CA** in  
seam at lower edge of sleeve; ch 1, work 21 (25) sc  
around; join with a sl st to first sc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, skip next sc, \* (2 dc, ch  
2, 2 dc) all in next sc, skip next sc \*\*, 2 sc in next sc,  
skip next sc; rep from \* to last sc, end at \*\*; sc in  
last sc; join.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, \* (sc, ch 2, sc) all in  
ch-2 sp \*\*, sc in next 6 sts; rep from \* to last 3 sts,  
end at \*\*; sc in last 3 sts; join.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 2, skip first sc, dc in next 3 sc, \*\* (dc, ch  
2, dc) all in ch-2 sp, dc in next 2 sc \*\*, [dc dec] twice,  
dc in next 2 dc; rep from \* to last 2 sc, end at \*\*; dc  
dec; join with a sl st to first dc changing to **CC.**

**Rnd 6:** With **CC,** ch 1, sc dec, sc in next 2 dc, \* (sc,  
ch 2, sc) all in ch-2 sp, sc in next 2 dc \*\*, [sc dec]  
twice, sc in next 2 dc; rep from \* to last 2 dc, end at  
\*\*; sc dec; join. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

ounce/312 yard solid; 4.5 ounce/245 yard  
multi skein).

**ABBREVIATIONS:** **beg** = beginning; **CA, CB, CC**  
= Color A, B, C; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet;  
**dec** = decrease; **hdc** = half double crochet; **lp(s)** =  
loop (s); **mm** = millimeters; **pat** = pattern; **rep** =  
repeat; **sc** = single crochet; **sl** = slip; **st(s)** = stitch  
(es); **yo** = yarn over; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever fol-  
lows the \* or \*\* as indicated; [] = work directions in  
brackets the number of times specified.
