



## Lacy Beaded Fingerless Gloves

KTV2024K



Directions are for size **Small/Medium**; changes for size **Medium/Large** are in parentheses.

**Nashua Handknits "June"**: 1 Ball 0003 Rose.

**Knitting Needles**: 4mm [US 6].

**Crochet Hook**: 3.5mm [US E-4].

Yarn needle, 1 package Westrim gold beads, #4997.

**GAUGE**: 22 sts = 4"; 28 rows = 4" in St st. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.**

**Finished Measurements**: 7 x 6 (8 x 6½)".

**LEFT GLOVE**: Cast on 38 (44) sts. Purl one row.

**Row 1 (Right Side)**: K6 (8), K2tog, K2, yo, K1, yo, K5, slip 1, K1, pssso, K20 (24).

**Row 2 and all Wrong Side Rows**: Purl.

**Row 3**: K6 (8), K2tog, K1, yo, K3, yo, K4, slip 1, K1 pssso, K20 (24).

**Row 5**: K6 (8), K2tog, yo, K5, yo, K3, slip 1, K1, pssso, K20 (24).

**Row 7**: K6 (8), K2tog, K5, yo, K1, yo, K2, slip 1, K1, pssso, K20 (24).

**Row 9**: K6 (8), K2tog, K4, yo, K3, yo, K1, slip 1, K1, pssso, K20 (24).

**Row 11**: K6 (8), K2tog, K3, yo, K5, yo, slip 1, K1, pssso, K20 (24).

**Row 12**: Purl.

Repeat Rows 1-12 once more.

**Size Medium/Large Only**: Repeat Rows 1-6 once more.

**Both Sizes**: Bind off.

**Lower Beaded Edge**: String 54 (63) beads onto yarn. If the tip of the yarn becomes dirty or frayed during the bead stringing, clip off the damaged part before continuing.

**Row 1**: With right side facing and crochet hook, join yarn to the cast-on edge; ch 1, sc in first st, ch 1, skip 1 st, [sc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] 17 (20) times; turn.

**Row 2**: Ch 2, [slide bead up against work, ch 1, sc in ch-1 space] 18 (21) times, sc in last sc; turn.

**Row 3**: Ch 4, sc in next sc, [ch 3, sc in next sc] 17 (20) times, ch 3, slip st in top of ch-2; turn.

**Row 4**: Ch 2, slide bead up against work, [ch 1, sc in ch-3 space, ch 1, slide bead up against work] 17 (20) times, ch 1, slip st in 2nd ch of ch-4. Fasten off.

**Top Beaded Edge**: With wrong side facing and crochet hook, join yarn to front loop of first st of bind-off edge; ch 1, sc in first sc, [slide a bead up against work, ch 1, skip 1 st, sc in front loop of next st] 18 (21) times. Fasten off.

**RIGHT GLOVE**: Cast on 38 (44) sts. Purl one row.

**Row 1 (Right Side)**: K20 (24), K2tog, K2, yo, K1, yo, K5, slip 1, K1, pssso, K6 (8).

**Row 2 and all Wrong Side Rows**: Purl.

**Row 3**: K20 (24), K2tog, K1, yo, K3, yo, K4, slip 1, K1 pssso, K6 (8).

**Row 5**: K20 (24), K2tog, yo, K5, yo, K3, slip 1, K1, pssso,

K6 (8).

**Row 7:** K20 (24), K2tog, K5, yo, K1, yo, K2, slip 1, K1, pssso, K6 (8).

**Row 9:** K20 (24), K2tog, K4, yo, K3, yo, K1, slip 1, K1, pssso, K6 (8).

**Row 11:** K20 (24), K2tog, K3, yo, K5, yo, slip 1, K1, pssso, K6 (8).

**Row 12:** Purl.

Repeat Rows 1-12 once more.

**Size Medium/Large Only:** Repeat Rows 1-6 once more.

**Both Sizes:** Bind off.

Complete same as for left glove.

**FINISHING-Thumb Opening:** With yarn needle, sew side seams from top edge for 1", leave an opening of 1½" for thumb, and then sew remainder of the seam below thumb hole.

**Thumb Opening Edging:** With right side facing and crochet hook, join yarn at thumb opening; ch 1, \* sc in st, ch 1, skip 2 sts; repeat from \* around opening; join with a slip st to first sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Nashua Handknits "June" available in 1.75oz (50g), 120yd (110m) balls.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** **ch** = chain; **K** = knit; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **P** = purl; **pssso** = pass the slipped st over; **St st** = Stockinette stitch (Knit on right side rows; Purl on wrong side rows.); **st(s)** = stitch (es); **tog** = together; **yo** = yarn over
