



Crochet Beaded Cobweb Lace Scarf

WC1845



INTERMEDIATE

Designed by Joan Barnett.

Scarf measures approximately 63" x 5".

AUNT LYDIA'S® "Bamboo Crochet Thread"; 2 balls 661 Zen Green.

Crochet Hooks: 2.25 mm [US B/1], 1.30 mm [US 10 steel].

1 package (3oz/85g) glass rochaille beads, size E 6/0, Iridescent Blue/Green

GAUGE: Using larger hook, one pattern repeat = 1 3/4" wide; 8 rows = 1 5/8". **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS:

PB (place bead): Remove loop from hook, switch to smaller hook, put hook through eye of bead, pick up loop and pull loop through bead, switch back to larger hook and continue with pattern.

SCARF

With larger hook, ch 62.

Row 1 (Right Side): Dc in 8th ch from hook (skipped chs count as dc and ch-2 space), dc in each ch across to last 3 chs, ch 2, sk next 2 chs, dc in last ch – 54 dc and 2 ch-2 spaces.

Row 2: PB, ch 4 (counts as dc and ch-2 space now and throughout), turn; sk first ch-2 space; *dc in next dc, ch 4, [sk next 2 dc, tr in next dc] 4 times, ch 4, sk next 2 dc, dc in next dc, ch 2**; sk next 2 dc; repeat from * 2 more times, ending last repeat at **; sk next 2 chs, dc in next ch – 12 tr, 8 dc, 6 ch-4 spaces and 4 ch-2 spaces.

Row 3: PB, ch 4, turn; sk first ch-2 space; *dc in next dc, ch 4, sc in next 4 tr, ch 4, dc in next dc, ch 2**; sk next ch-2 space; repeat from * 2 more times, ending last repeat at **; sk next 2 chs, dc in next ch – 12 sc, 8 dc, 6 ch-4 spaces and 4 ch-2 spaces.

Row 4: PB, ch 4, turn; sk first ch-2 space; *dc in next dc, ch 4, sc in next 2 sc, PB, sc in next 2 sc, ch 4, dc in next dc, ch 2**; sk next ch-2 space; repeat from * 2 more times, ending last repeat at **; sk next 2 chs, dc in next ch.

Rows 5-6: PB, ch 4, turn; sk first ch-2 space; *dc in next dc, ch 4, sc in next 4 sc, ch 4, dc in next dc, ch 2**; sk next ch-2 space; repeat from * 2 more times, ending last repeat at **; sk next 2 chs, dc in next ch.

Row 7: PB, ch 4, turn; sk first ch-2 space; *dc in next dc, [ch 2, tr in next sc] 4 times, ch 2, dc in next dc, ch 2**; sk next ch-2 space; repeat from * 2 more times, ending last repeat at **; sk next 2 chs, dc in next ch – 12 tr, 8 dc and 19 ch-2 spaces.

Row 8: PB, ch 4, turn; sk first ch-2 space; *dc in next dc, [2 dc in next ch-2 space, dc in next tr] 4 times, 2 dc in next ch-2 space, dc in next dc**; 2 dc in next ch-2 space; repeat from * 2 more times, ending last repeat at **; ch 2, sk next 2 chs, dc in next ch – 54 dc and 2 ch-2 spaces.

Repeat Rows 2-8, 36 more times. Do not fasten off.

Edging

Row 1: PB, ch 4, turn; sk first ch-2 space, dc in next dc; *ch 1, PB, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * across to turning ch-space; ch 1, PB, ch 1 (count as ch2), sk next 2 chs, dc in next ch.



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Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as dc), turn; *3 dc in next ch-2 space, dc in next dc, [ch 3, sk next ch-2 space, dc in next dc] twice; repeat from * 5 more times; 3 dc in turning ch-space, dc in 2nd ch of turning ch-4.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc and ch-1 space), turn; [dc in next 3 dc, ch 3, sk next dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, sk next dc] 6 times; dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, dc in 2nd ch of turning ch-2.

Row 4: Ch 4, turn; sk first ch-1 space and next dc, dc in next dc; *PB, ch 2, sk next dc, ([tr, ch 1] 3 times, tr) in next sc, ch 2, sk next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * 5 more times; ch 2, sk next dc and next ch-1 space, dc in 2nd ch of turning ch-3. Fasten off.

Beginning Edging

Row 1: With right side facing and larger hook, working in free loops of foundation ch, join with slip st in first ch, PB, ch 4, sk next 2 chs, dc in next ch; [ch 1, PB, ch 1, sk next 2 chs, dc in next ch] 17 times; ch 1, PB, ch 1, sk next 2 chs, dc in next ch.

Rows 2-4: Work same as Rows 2-4 on Edging.

FINISHING: Weave in ends.

Blocking: Pin scarf to a flat surface and stretch slightly to open up the motifs. Mist with water and let dry.

ABBREVIATIONS: **ch(s)** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **sk** = skip; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tr** = treble crochet; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; () = work directions in parentheses into the specified st or space.



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
