Cardigan directions are for size 3 months; changes for sizes 6 and 12 months are in parentheses. Bonnet and booties are for size 3 months.

AUNT LYDIA'S® "Bamboo Crochet Thread": 4 (4, 5) Balls 1 White.

Steel Crochet Hook: 1.60mm [US 6].
Tapestry needle.

GAUGE: 36 sts (6 shell repeats) = 4"; 20 rows = 4" in pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**

To Fit Chest: 16 (17, 18)".

Finished Chest Measurement: 19 (20, 21)".

Booties are 4" long

CARDIGAN

BACK: Begin at top (shoulder) edge, ch 86 (92, 98).

Row 1 (Right Side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, * skip next 2 ch; 5 dc in next ch – shell made; skip next 2 ch, sc in next ch; repeat from * across; turn – 14 (15, 16) shells.

Row 2: Ch 3, 2 dc in first sc, * skip 2 dc, sc in next dc, skip 2 dc **, shell in next sc; repeat from * to last st, end at **; 3 dc in last sc; turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first dc, * skip 2 dc, shell in next sc, skip 2 dc, sc in next dc; repeat from * across working last sc in top of ch-3; turn.

Rows 4-32 (38, 42): Repeat Rows 2 and 3, end by working Row 2. Fasten off.

FRONT (Make 2): Begin at top (shoulder) edge, ch 44 (44, 50). Work same as Back over 7 (7, 8) shells for 32 (38, 42) rows. Fasten off.

SLEEVES (Make 2): Begin at top (armhole) edge, ch 74 (80, 86). Work same as Back over 12 (13, 14) shells for 31 (33, 37) rows. Fasten off.

FINISHING: Sew shoulder seams across 14 sts from shoulder edge toward neck. Place center of sleeve tops at shoulder seams and sew in place. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Girl's Ruffled Sleeve Edging

Rnd 1: With right side facing, join in seam; ch 3, 2 dc in first dc, * 3 hdc in next dc, sc in next 3 sts, 3 hdc in next dc **, 5 dc in next dc; repeat from * to last dc, end at **; 3 dc in last dc; join in top of ch-3. Fasten off.

Boy's Smooth Edging

Rnd 1: With right side facing, join in seam; ch 1, sc in first 2 dc, * hdc in next dc, dc in next sc, hdc in next dc **, sc in next 3 dc; repeat from * to last 2 dc, end at **; sc in last 2 dc; join in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join in first sc. Fasten off.



Boy's Smooth Edging



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Girl's Collar

Row 1: With wrong side facing, join yarn at upper corner of left front; ch 1, work 115 (121, 139) sc evenly spaced across left front, back neck, and to corner of right front corner; turn – 115 (121, 139) sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in front loops of each sc across; turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, 2 dc in first sc, * skip 2 sc, sc in next sc, skip 2 sc **, shell in next sc; repeat from * to last sc; 3 dc in last sc; turn – 19 (20, 23) shells.

Rows 4-6: Repeat Rows 3 and 2 of Back. Fasten off.

Boy's Collar

Rows 1-5: Work same as Rows 1-5 of Girl's Collar.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in first 2 dc, * hdc in next dc, dc in next sc, hdc in next dc, sc in next 3 dc; repeat from * across working last sc in top of ch-3. Fasten off.

Girl's Hem and Front Edging

Row 1: With right side facing, join to left front just below collar; ch 1, work 62 (74, 74) sc evenly down front edge, work Row 3 of Back across lower edge to corner of right front, work 62 (74, 74) sc evenly up front edge to just below the collar; turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, * 3 hdc in next st, 5 dc in next st **, 3 hdc in next st ***, sc in next 3 sts; repeat from * across, end at **; work across lower edge: sc in next dc; repeat from * across lower edge, end at **; 3 hdc in next st, sc in next st; work up next front: 5 dc in next st, 3 hdc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; repeat from * up front, end at ***; sc in last sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Boy's Hem and Front Edging

Row 1: With right side facing, join to left front just below collar; ch 1, work 62 (74, 74) sc evenly down front edge, work across lower edge: sc in first 2 dc, * hdc in next dc, dc in next sc, hdc in next dc **, sc in next 3 dc; repeat from * to last 2 dc, end at **; sc in last 2 dc, work 62 (74, 74) sc evenly up front edge to just below the collar; turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st around increasing at corners to keep work flat. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

BONNET: Ch 122. Begin at front edge and work in pattern same as Back over 20 shells for 24 rows. Fasten off.

Back-Row 25: With right side facing, skip first 42 sts, join yarn and work in pattern across next 37 sts; turn, leaving remaining 42 sts unworked.

Rows 26-48: Work in pattern. Fasten off.

FINISHING: Sew row ends of Back to unworked sts of Row 24.

Girl's Ruffled Neck Edging

Row 1: With wrong side facing, join yarn at corner of right front; ch 1, work 30 sc evenly across row ends to seam, work in pattern across to next seam, work 30 sc evenly across row ends to corner of left front; turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, 4 dc in first sc, * 3 hdc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, 3 hdc in next st **, 5 dc in next st; repeat from * to last st, end at **; 3 dc in last sc. Fasten off.

Boy's Smooth Edging

Row 1: With wrong side facing, join yarn at corner of right front; ch 1, work 30 sc evenly across row ends to seam, sc in next 2 dc, * hdc in next dc, dc in next sc, hdc in next dc **, sc in next 3 sts; repeat from * to last 2 sts before seam, end at **; sc in next 2 sts, work 30 sc evenly across row ends to corner of left front; turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across. Fasten off.

Boy (Girl) Face Edging

Row 1: With right side facing, join yarn at corner of right front to work across beginning ch; ch 3 (2), 4 (0) more dc in same st, * 3 hdc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, 3 hdc in next st, 5 dc in next st; repeat from * across working 5 (0) dc in last st. Fasten off.

Ties (Make 2): Ch 62.

Row 1 (Wrong Side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; turn – 61 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, * skip 2 sc, 5 dc in next sc, skip 2 sc, sc in next sc; repeat from * across. Fasten off. Attach one tie at each front corner of bonnet.

BOOTIES (Make 2): Ch 23.

Sole-Rnd 1: 5 Dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in next 18 ch, 6 dc in last ch, pivot to work in unused loops of foundation ch, dc in next 18 ch; join with a slip st in top of ch-3 – 48 sts.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, dc in same st, 2 dc in each of next 5 dc, dc in next 18 dc, 2 dc in each of next 6 dc, dc in last 18 dc; join – 60 sts.

Rnd 3: Ch 3, dc in same st, dc in next dc, [2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc] 5 times, dc in next 18 dc, [2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc] 6 times, dc in last 18 dc; join – 72 sts.

Rnd 4: Ch 3, dc in same st, dc in next 2 dc, [2 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc] 5 times, dc in next 18 dc, [2 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc] 6 times, dc in last 18 dc; join – 84 sts.

Rnd 5: Ch 3, dc in same st, dc in next 3 dc, [2 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc] 5 times, dc in next 18 dc, [2 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc] 6 times, dc in next 18 dc; join – 96 sts.

Foot-Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in same st, * skip 2 dc, shell in next dc, skip 2 dc **, sc in next dc; repeat from * around, end at **; join with a slip st in first sc – 16 shells.



Rnd 7: Ch 3, 4 dc in same st, * skip next 2 dc, sc in next dc, skip next 2 dc **, shell in next sc; repeat from * around, end at **: join in top of ch-3.

Rnd 8: Slip st in next dc, ch 1, sc in next dc, [skip 2 dc, shell in next sc, skip 2 dc, sc in next dc] 12 times, [skip 2 dc, sc in next st] twice, [skip 2 dc, shell in next sc, skip 2 dc, sc in next dc] twice, skip 2 dc, shell in next sc; join – 15 shells.

Divide for Ankle-Rnd 9: Ch 3, 4 dc in same st, [skip 2 dc, sc in next dc, skip 2 dc, shell in next sc] 6 times, skip 2 dc, sc in next dc, place marker in same dc, ch 11, skip next 6 shells, skip 2 dc, sc in next dc, shell in next sc, skip 2 dc, sc in next dc; join in top of ch-3 – 8 shells.

Rnd 10: Slip st in next dc, ch 1, sc in next dc, skip 2 dc, [shell in next sc, skip 2 dc, sc in next dc, skip 2 dc] 6 times, shell in next sc, skip 2 ch, sc in next ch, skip 2 ch, shell in next ch, skip 2 ch, sc in next ch, skip 2 ch, shell in next sc, skip 2 dc, sc in next dc, shell in next sc; join – 10 shells.

Rnd 11: Repeat Rnd 7 – 10 shells.

Rnd 12: Slip st in next dc, ch 1, sc in next dc, * skip 2 dc, shell in next sc, skip 2 dc **, sc in next dc; repeat from * around, end at **: join.

Rnd 13: Slip st in next 2 dc, ch 3, dc in same st, 2 dc in each of next 2 dc, [ch 2, skip 3 sts, 2 dc in each of next 3 dc] 9 times, ch 2; join – 10 ch-2 spaces. Fasten off.

Top of Foot Flap-Row 1: Join in marked dc on Rnd 9, ch 1, sc in same dc, [skip 2 dc, shell in next sc, skip 2 dc, sc in next dc] 3 times, 3 dc in next sc (half shell made), skip 2 dc, slip st in next dc; turn – 3 1/2 shells.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first dc, [shell in next sc, skip 2 dc, sc in next dc] 3 times; turn – 3 shells.

Row 3: Ch 3, 2 dc in first sc (half shell made), [skip 2 dc, sc in next dc, 5 dc in next sc] 3 times, skip next 2 dc on Rnd 8, sc in next sc; turn – 3 1/2 shells.

Row 4: Ch 1, slip st in first 3 sts, ch 1, sc in next dc, * 5 dc in next sc, skip 2 dc, sc in next dc; repeat from * across working last sc in top of ch-3; turn – 3 shells.

Row 5: Ch 3, 2 dc in first sc, skip 2 dc, sc in next dc, skip 2 dc, 5 dc in next sc, skip 2 dc, sc in next dc, skip 2 dc, 3 dc in last sc; turn – 1 shell and 2 half shells.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in first dc, [shell in next sc, skip 2 dc, sc in next dc] twice working last sc in top of ch-3; turn – 2 shells.

Row 7: Repeat Row 5. Fasten off.

FINISHING: Sew the flap in place to the remainder of Rnd 8, easing to fit to create a flat seam across the instep and toes.

Ties (Make 2): Work same as Bonnet Ties. Weave in and out of the ch-2 spaces of Rnd 13. Weave in all ends.
