



## WC1072 Garden Patch Hot Pad

**Coats® "Crème de la Creme™":** 1 ball of No. 679 Spruce CA, small amounts of No. 119 Scarlet CB, No. 252 Brite Orange CC, No. 101 Cream CD; very small amount of No. 620 Green Shadow CE.

**Crochet Hook:** 4.0mm [US G-6].  
Yarn needle.

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**GAUGE:** 5 sc = 1"; 4 rows = 1". **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**  
**Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**

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Pad measure approx 9.5" wide x 9.5" high

### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS:

**FPdc** (front post dc) = Yarn over hook, insert hook around indicated st from front to back to front, yarn over and draw loop around st, [yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

**BPdc** (back post dc) = Yarn over hook, insert hook around indicated st from back to front to back, yarn over and draw loop around st, [yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

**FPbob** (front post bobble) = [Yarn over hook, insert hook around indicated st from front to back to front, yarn over and draw loop around st, yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook] 4 times, change to color indicated, yarn over hook and draw through all 5 loops on hook.

**Center:** With CA, ch 29.

**Row 1 (WS):** Dc in 2nd ch from hook and in each rem ch across, turn – 28 dc.

**Row 2 (RS):** Ch 2 (counts as a dc), dc in next 2 dc, FPdc around next dc, [dc in next 3 dc, FPdc around next dc] 5 times, dc in next 3 dc, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, BPdc around next st, [dc in next 3 dc, BPdc around next st] 5 times, dc in next 3 dc, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, FPdc around next st, [dc in next dc, changing to CB, FPbob around next dc, changing to CA (carry CB behind work, working sts over strand), dc in next dc, FPdc around next st, dc in next 3 dc, FPdc around next dc] twice; dc in next dc, changing to CB, FPbob around next dc, changing to CA, dc in next dc, FPdc around next st, dc in next 3 dc, turn. Fasten off CB.

**Row 5:** Rep Row 3.

**Row 6:** Ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, FPdc around next st, [dc in next 3 dc, FPdc around next st, [dc in next dc, changing to CC, ch 3, sl st around front post of next dc 2 rows below, turn, 3 sc in ch-3 sp, changing to CA in last sc, dc in next dc, FPdc around next st] twice, dc in next 3 FPdc, dc in next 3 dc, turn. Fasten off CC.

**Row 7:** Rep Row 3.

**Row 8:** Rep Row 4, using CD instead of CC.

**Row 9:** Rep Row 3.

**Row 10:** Rep Row 6.

**Row 11:** Rep Row 3.

**Row 12:** Rep Row 4.

**Row 13:** Rep Row 3.

**Row 14:** Rep Row 6.

**Row 15:** Rep Row 3.

**Row 16:** Rep Row 2. Fasten off.

### Edging:

**Rnd 1:** With RS facing, join CA with sl st in 2nd ch of beg ch-2 of Row 16, ch 2, 2 dc in same sp, dc in next 2 dc, changing to CD in last dc, FPdc around next dc, changing to CA, [dc in next 3 dc, changing to CD in last dc, FPdc around next dc, changing to CA] 5 times, dc in next 2 dc, 3 dc in next dc; do Not turn; working across next side, 2 dc in end of Row 15, changing to CD in last dc, FPdc around top of last dc of Row 14, changing to CA, dc in end of Row 14 and in end of Row 13, 2 dc in end of row 12, changing to CD in last dc, FPdc in top of last dc of Row 11, changing to CA, dc in end of Row 11 and in end of Row 10, 2 dc in end of Row 9, changing to CD in last dc, FPdc around top of last dc of Row 8, changing to CA, dc in end of Row 8 and in end of Row 7, 2 dc in end of Row 6, changing to CD in last dc, FPdc in top of last dc of Row 5, changing to CA, dc in end of Row 5 and in end of Row 4, 2 dc in end of Row 3, changing to CD in last dc, FPdc around top of last dc of Row 2, dc in end of Row 2, 3 dc in end of Row 1, working across next side, [dc in unused lps of next 3 chs, changing to CD in last dc, FPdc around next dc on Row 1, changing to CA] 6 times, dc in unused lps of next 3 chs, working across next side, 3 dc in side of Row 1, changing to CD in last dc, FPdc around top of last dc of Row 1, changing to CA, 2 dc in end of Row 2 and in end of Row 3, changing to CD in last dc, FPdc around top of last dc of Row 3, changing to CA, 2 dc in end of Row 4 and in end of Row 5, changing to CD in last dc, FPdc around top of last dc of Row 5, changing to CA, dc in end of Row 6, 2 dc in end of Row 7, dc in end of Row 8, changing to CD, FPdc in top of last dc of Row 8, changing to CA, dc in end of Row 9, 2 dc in end of Row 10, dc in end of Row 11, changing to CD, FPdc around top of last dc of Row 11, changing to CA, dc in end of Row 12, 2 dc in end of Row 13, dc in end of Row 14, changing to CD, FPdc around top of last dc of Row 14, changing to CA, dc in end of Row 15, 2 dc in end of Row 16, join with a sl st in 2nd ch of beg ch-2.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 2, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 4 dc, changing to CD in last dc, FPdc around next FPdc, changing to CA, [dc in next 3 dc, changing to CD in last dc, FPdc around next FPdc, changing to CA] 5 times, dc in next 3 dc, 3 dc in next dc; dc in next 3 dc, changing to CD in last dc, [FPdc around next FPdc, changing to CA, dc in next 4 dc, changing to CD in last dc] 4 times, FPdc around next FPdc, changing to CA, dc in next 3 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 4 dc, changing to CD in last dc, [FPdc around next FPdc, changing to CA, dc in next 3 dc] 6 times, dc in next dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, changing to CD, FPdc around next FPdc, changing to CA, [dc in next 4 dc, changing to CD in last dc, FPdc around next FPdc, changing to CA] 5 times, dc in next 3 dc, join with a sl st in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. Fasten off.

**Rnd 3:** Join CD with a sl st in 2nd sc of any 3-sc corner, ch 1, 3 sc in same sp, sc in each sc and 3 sc in 2nd sc of each rem corner, join with a sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

**Carrot Tops:** Cut 3-inch lengths of CE. Tie one length to top of each carrot.

**FINISHING:** With CD, work ch st between Rows 16 and 17.  
Weave in ends.

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(4 Medium) Coats® "Crème de la Creme™", Art. 149 (2.5 ounce/126 yard ball).

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**ABBREVIATIONS:** **approx** = approximate; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **lp** = loop; **mm** = millimeters; **rep** = repeat; **sc** = single crochet; **sl** = slip; **sp** = space; **st(s)** = stitch (es); **tog** = together; **tr** = treble crochet; **yo** = yarn over needle; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
