



# Dreamy Quilt Throw

WR1829



EXPERIENCED

Designed by Katherine Eng

Throw is 45" wide x 47" long.

**RED HEART® "Eco-Ways™":** 3 skeins 3313 Oyster **A**, 2 skeins 3380 Cornflower Blue **B** and 1 skein each 3114 Chamois **C**, 1821 Blue Cloud **D**, 1615 Lichen **E**, 3533 Misty Violet **F** and 2316 Storm **G**.

**Crochet Hook:** 5.5mm (US I-9).  
Yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 12 sts = 4"; 8 rows = 4" in dc. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the specified gauge.**

## Pattern Stitch

**Row/Round 1:** \*Ch 1, skip next sc, sc in next sc; repeat from \*.

**Row/Round 2:** Sc in each ch-1 space and sc.  
Repeat Row/Rounds 1-2 for pattern stitch

## QUILT

### Section 1

With **C**, ch 34.

**Row 1 (Right Side):** Working in back loops of ch only, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 33 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, \*skip next sc, 3 dc in next sc, skip next sc, sc in next sc; repeat from \* across.

**Row 3:** Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), turn, dc in first sc, \*sc in center dc of 3-dc group, 3 dc in next sc; repeat from \* across, end sc in center dc of 3-dc group, 2 dc in last sc.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, \*3 dc in next sc, sc in center dc of next 3-dc group; repeat from \* across, end 3 dc in next sc, sc in top of turning ch.

**Rows 5-12:** Repeat 3 and 4.

**Row 13:** Ch 2, (counts as hdc), turn, \*sc in next dc, slip st in next dc, sc in next dc, hdc in next sc; repeat from \* across.

**Round 1:** Ch 1, turn to work along edge of rows, work 18 sc evenly spaced along side edges working 1 sc in each sc row and 2 sc at in each dc row, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner, turn to work along remaining loops of beginning ch, sc in each sc across, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner, turn to work along opposite side edge, sc 18 sts evenly spaced across, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner, turn to work across Row 13, sc in each sc across, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner slip st to first st to join.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, sc in next sc around, working (sc, ch 2, sc) in each corner ch-2 space, slip st to first st to join.  
Fasten off.

### Section 2

**Round 1:** With right side facing, join **E** in 2nd sc to left of corner ch-2 space on one long edge, ch 1, sc in same sc and in each sc around, working (sc, ch 2, sc) in each corner ch-2 space, slip st to first st to join.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in next sc, ch 1, skip next sc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner ch-2 space, \*ch 1, skip next sc, sc in next sc; repeat from \* around, working (sc, ch 2, sc) in each corner ch-2 space, ch 1, slip st to first st to join.

**Round 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each ch-1 space and sc around, working (sc, ch 2, sc) in each corner ch-2 space, slip st to first sc to join.

**Rounds 4-12:** Work in Pattern st as established.  
Fasten off.





### Section 3

**Row 1:** With right side facing, join **D** in 9th ch-1 space from corner ch-2 space along one short edge, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in each sc and ch-1 space to corner ch-2 space, (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 space, sc in each sc and ch-1 space to next corner ch-2 space, sc in ch-2 space.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, \*ch 1, skip next sc, sc in next sc; repeat from \* to first st, working (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner ch-2 space, ch 1, slip st to first st to join.

**Rows 3-7:** Work in Pattern st as established.  
Fasten off.

### Section 4

**Row 1:** With right side facing, join **D** in 10th ch-1 space from corner ch-2 space along opposite short edge, work as for Section 3 along opposite edges.

**Rows 2-7:** Work in Pattern st as established.  
Fasten off.

### Section 5

**Row 1:** With right side facing, join **F** in last st of Section 4, work 5 sc along row edges of Section 4, sc in each sc across to first st of Section 3, slip st in row edge of Section 3 – 25 sc.

**Rows 2-7:** Ch 1, turn, work in Pattern st, slip st in row edge of Section 3 every other row to join.

### Section 6

Work as for Section 5 on opposite side – 27 sc.

### Section 7

**Round 1:** With wrong side facing and ready to work along one short edge, join **B** in corner ch-2 space, sc in ch-2 space (counts as first sc of corner), sc in each sc around, working (sc, ch 2, sc) in each corner ch-2 space to first ch-2 space, sc, ch 2, slip st to first st to join.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in next sc, \*5 dc in corner ch-2 space, skip next sc, sc in next sc, [skip 2 sc, 5 dc in next sc, skip 2 sc, sc in next sc] across to 1 st before next corner ch-2 space, skip 1 sc, 5 dc in corner ch-2 space, sc in next st, work between [] across to corner ch-2 space; repeat from \* to first st, slip st to first st to join.

**Round 3:** Slip st to 2nd dc of corner 5-dc group, ch 1, turn, sc in same dc, 5 dc in center dc, sc in next dc, skip 1 dc, [5 dc in next sc, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group] around, working (skip 1 dc, sc in next dc, 5 dc in center dc, sc in next dc, skip 1 dc) in each corner 5-dc group, slip st in first st to join.

**Rounds 4-7:** Repeat Round 3.

**Round 8:** Slip st to first dc of corner 5-dc group, hdc in first dc, sc in next dc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in center st, sc in next dc,

hdc in next dc in corner 5-dc group, [dc in each sc, (hdc in first dc, sc in next 3 dc, hdc in next dc) in each 5-dc group] around, working (hdc in first dc, sc in next dc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in center st, sc in next dc, hdc in next dc) in each corner 5-dc group, slip st in first st to join – 109 sts along each long edge and 97 sts along each short edge.

Fasten off.

### Section 8

**Row 1:** With right side facing, join **F** in 46th st from corner ch-2 space along one short side, ch 1, sc in each st across working (sc, ch 2, sc) in each corner ch-2 space, slip st in first st to join.

**Rows 2-7:** Work as for Section 3.  
Fasten off.

### Section 9

**Row 1:** With right side facing, join **F** in 44th st from corner ch-2 space along opposite short side, ch 1, sc in each st across working (sc, ch 2, sc) in each corner ch-2 space, slip st in first st to join.

**Rows 2-7:** Work as for Section 3.  
Fasten off.

### Section 10

**Row 1:** With right side facing, join **D** in last st of Section 9, work 5 sc along row edges of Section 9, sc in each sc across to first st of Section 8, slip st in row edge of Section 8 – 53 sc.

**Rows 2-7:** Ch 1, turn, work in Pattern st, slip st in row edge of Section 8 every other row to join.  
Fasten off.

### Section 11

Work as for Section 10 on opposite side – 51 sc.

### Section 12

**Row 1:** With right side facing, join **A** in corner st of Section 10, ch 1, sc in each sc across to corner ch-2 space of Section 8 – 113 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, \*ch 1, skip next sc, sc in next sc; repeat from \* across.  
Fasten off.

**Row 3:** With right side facing, join **G** in first st, ch 2 (counts as sc and ch 1), skip next ch-1 space, slip st in next sc, \*ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, slip st in next sc; repeat from \* across.  
Fasten off.

**Row 4:** With right side facing, join **A** in first ch, ch 1, sc in same st, working in back loops only, \*ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next slip st; repeat from \* across.





**Row 5:** Repeat Row 2.  
Rows 6-23: Repeat Rows 3-5.  
Fasten off.

**Section 13**  
Work as for Section along opposite short edge.

**Section 14**  
**Row 1:** With right side facing, join **A** in first sc of Section 13, ch 1, skipping slip st rows, sc 20 sts evenly across edges of rows of Section 13, sc in next corner ch 2 sp. sc in each sc across Section 9, sc 7 sts evenly spaced along edges of Section 10, sc 20 sts evenly across edges of rows of Section 12 – 165 sc.

**Rows 2-29:** Work as for Section 12.  
Fasten off.

**Section 15**  
Work as for Section 14 along opposite long edge.

**Border**  
With right side facing, join **A** in any corner sc, (sc, ch 3, sc) in corner sc, \*ch 1, skip next st, slip st in next ch-1 space or st; repeat from \* evenly spaced around, working (sc, ch 3, sc) in each corner st, slip st to first st to join.  
Fasten off.

**FINISHING**  
Weave in ends.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** **A, B**, etc= color A, B, etc; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
