

Beach Wrap



One size fits most women.

AUNT LYDIA'S® “Classic Crochet” thread: Art. 151, 100% cotton, size 10 thread, 350 yard balls: 2 balls No. 493 French Rose.

Crochet Hook: 5 mm [US H-8]
Small yarn needle, two 32 mm brass rings.

GAUGE: 18 sts = 4”; 7 alternating rows of sc and dc = 4”. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge given.

Ch 166

Row 1 (Right Side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; turn – 165 sts.

Row 2: Ch 3, skip first st, dc in each st across; turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each st across; turn.

Rows 4-95: Rep Rows 2 and 3.

Rnd 96: Working around the outside edge, ch 1 (first corner), 2 sc in same st as last st of row 95, sc in each st and row ends around working 2 sc in each dc row end and 3 sc in each corner; join with sl st to beg sc; turn.

Rnd 97: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Fold one corner of top edge over both rings held tog and stitch corner to Wrap, securing rings. To fasten top, insert opposite corner at top edge into both rings, fold back over closest ring and under 2nd ring; tighten.
