Afghan measures approximately 45" x 58".

TLC® "Cotton Plus™": 6 Balls 3533 Periwinkle **CA**, 3 balls 3643 Kiwi **CB**, 2 balls 3100 Cream **CC**.

Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9].
Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 1 chevron repeat = 6"; 9 rows = 4" in pattern.
CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Beginning at **top** of afghan with **CA**, ch 195.

Row 1 (Right Side): Dc in 4th ch from hook and in next 10 ch, * (dc, ch 3, dc) all in next ch, dc in next 12 ch **, skip next 3 ch, dc in next 12 ch; rep from * across, end at; turn ** – 7 chevrons.

Row 2: Ch 1, skip first dc, * [sc in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc] 6 times, (sc, ch 2, sc) all in ch-3 sp, [ch 1, skip next dc, sc in next dc] 6 times **, skip next 2 dc; rep from * across, end at ** leaving turning ch unworked; turn.

Row 3: Sl st in first ch-1 sp, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), skip next sc, * [dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, skip next sc] 5 times, (dc, ch 3, dc) all in ch-2 sp, [ch 1, skip next sc, dc in next ch-1 sp] 6 times **, skip next 2 sc, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, skip next sc; rep from * across changing to **CB** in last dc, end at ** leaving last sc unworked; turn.

Row 4: With **CB**, ch 1, * [sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, skip next dc] 6 times, (sc, ch 2, sc) all in ch-3 sp, [ch 1, skip next dc, sc in next ch-1 sp] 6 times **, skip next 2 dc; rep from * across, end at **; turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, skip first sc, * [sc in next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc] 6 times, (sc, ch 2, sc) all in ch-2 sp, [sc in next sc, sc in next ch-1 sp] 6 times **, skip next 2 sc; rep from * across, end at ** leaving last sc unworked; turn.

Row 6: Rep Row 5 changing to **CC** in last sc.

Row 7: With **CC**, rep Row 3 but do not change color at end of row. Fasten off.

Row 8: With right side facing, attach **CA** in first ch-1 sp, ch 3, * dc in next dc, [dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc] 5 times, (dc, ch 3, dc) all in ch-3 sp, [dc in next dc, dc in next ch-1 sp] 6 times **, skip next 2 dc, dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * across, end at **; turn.

Rows 9-115: Rep Rows 2-8 fifteen more times, then rep Rows 2 and 3 again. Do not change to **CB** at end of last row. Continue with **CA**.

Right Side Edging-Row 1 (Right Side): With **CA**, ch 1, working in ends of rows along side edge, work an odd number of sc evenly across edge, taking care to keep work flat; turn.

Rows 2-5: Ch 1, sc in each sc across; turn. Fasten off.

Left Side Edging: With right side facing, attach **CA** at left edge and work same as Right Edging.

Border: With right side facing and foundation ch edge at top, join **CA** in 3rd sc of last row of Right Side Edging; *working across right edge:* ch 1, * (sc, ch 2, sc) all in sc, skip next sc; rep from * across; *working in ends of rows of Right Side Edging:* (sc, ch 3, sc) all in first row end, [skip next row, (sc, ch 2, sc) all in end of next row] twice; *working across top in free loops of foundation ch:* * [ch 2, skip next ch, sl st in next ch] 6 times, skip next ch, sl st in next ch, [ch 2, skip next ch, sl st in next ch] 5 times **, ch 2, skip next ch, (sl st, ch 4, sl st) all in ch-3 sp; rep from * across, end at **; *working in ends of rows of Left Side Edging:* ch 2, [(sc, ch 2, sc) all in end of next row, skip next row] twice, (sc, ch 3, sc) all in last row; *working across left edge:* skip next sc, * (sc, ch 2, sc) all in next sc, skip next sc; rep from * across; *working in ends of rows of Left Side Edging:* (sc, ch 3, sc) all in first row, [skip next row, (sc, ch 2, sc) all in end of next row] twice; *working across lower edge:* ch 2, * sl st in next ch-1 sp, [ch 2, skip next dc, sl st in next ch-1 sp] 5 times, ch 2, skip next dc, (sl st, ch 4, sl st) all in ch-3 sp, [ch 2, skip next dc, sl st in next ch-1 sp] 6 times **, skip next 2 dc; rep from * across; *working in ends of rows of Right Side Edging:* ch 2, [(sc, ch 2, sc) all in end of next row, skip next row] twice, (sc, ch 3, sc) all in last row, skip next sc; join with a sl st in first sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

(4 Medium) **TLC® "Cotton Plus™"**, Art. E516, available in solid color – 3.5oz (100g), 178yd (163m), and multi-color 3oz (85g), 153yd (139m) balls.

ABBREVIATIONS: **CA, CB, CC** = color A, B, C; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **rep** = repeat; **sc** = single crochet; **sl st** = slip stitch; **sp** = space; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated; [] work directions in brackets the number of times specified.

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
