

# Three of a Kind

## LW1390★

★ *Suitable for a beginner.*

**TLC® “Amoré™”,** Art. E515 (6 ounce solid/4.5 ounce multicolor skeins).

**Knitting Needles:** 5mm [US 8].

Yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 28 sts = 5<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>"; 22 rows = 4" in pat.

**CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

### ONE SKEIN SCARF

**Scarf measures approximately 5<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 62".**

**Yarn Amount:** 4.5 Ounces No. 3934 Plum Print.

Cast on 28 sts. Marking first row as the right side, work in pat as follows: \* K1, P1; rep from \* across.

Rep last row for pat until 62" from beg or until all but 1 yard of yarn is used up. Bind off loosely in pat. Weave in ends.

### TWO COLOR SCARF

**Scarf measures approximately 5<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 78".**

**Yarn Amount:** 3 Ounces each No. 3103 Vanilla and 3005 Sand.

With Vanilla, cast on 28 sts. Marking first row as the right side, work in pat as follows: \* K1, P1; rep from \* across.

Rep last row for pat and work \* 24 rows with Vanilla, then 24 rows with Sand. Rep from \* until 9 stripes of each color have been worked. Bind off loosely in pat. Weave in ends.

### NINE COLOR SCARF

**Scarf measures approximately 5<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 70<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>".**

**Yarn Amount:** <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Ounce each of 9 colors:

No. 3823 Lake Blue,

No. 3103 Vanilla,

No. 3710 Rose,

No. 3907 Red Velvet,

No. 3625 Celery,

No. 3995 Lagoon Print,

No. 3005 Sand,

No. 3934 Plum Print, and

No. 3782 Garnet.

With Lake Blue, cast on 28 sts. Marking first row as the right side, work in pat as follows: \* K1, P1; rep from \* across.

Rep last row for pat and work as follows:

3 more rows Lake Blue,

\* 2 rows Vanilla,

4 rows Rose,

4 rows Red Velvet,

2 rows Celery,

2 rows Red Velvet,

2 rows Vanilla,

4 rows Lagoon Print,

2 rows Vanilla,

6 rows Sand,

2 rows Vanilla,

2 rows Rose,

2 rows Plum Print,

4 rows Celery,

4 rows Garnet,

2 rows Vanilla,

6 rows Sand,

6 rows Rose,

2 rows Garnet,

2 rows Vanilla,

4 rows Lake Blue.

Rep from \* 5 more times. Bind off loosely in pat. Weave in ends.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** beg = begin (ning); K = knit; mm = millimeters; P = purl; pat = pattern; rep = repeat; st(s) = stitch (es); \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
