



# Vintage Crochet Pineapple Doily

WC1717



Doily measures 9" in diameter.

**AUNT LYDIA'S® "Bamboo": 1 Ball 226 Natural.**

**Susan Bates® Steelite® Crochet Hook: 1.5mm [US 7].**

Tapestry needle to weave in ends.

**GAUGE:** Rnds 1-3 = 2" across. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**  
**Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**

Ch 16; join with a slip st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), 41 dc in ring; join with a slip st in top of ch-3 – 42 sts.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 3, dc in same ch as joining, \* ch 3, skip 2 dc \*\*, 2 dc in next dc; repeat from \* around, end at \*\*; join in top of ch-3 – 14 ch-3 spaces.

**Rnd 3:** Slip st in next dc and next space; (ch 3, dc, ch 2,

2 dc) all in same space – beginning shell made; \* (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) all in next space – shell made; repeat from \* around; join – 14 shells.

**Rnd 4:** Beginning shell, ch 1, \* (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) all in ch-2 space of next shell – shell over shell made; ch 1; repeat from \* around; join.

**Rnd 5:** Beginning shell, ch 2, \* shell over shell, ch 2; repeat from \* around; join.

**Rnd 6:** Slip st in next dc and next space; (ch 3, dc, ch 5, 2 dc) all in same space, \* ch 4, shell over shell, ch 4 \*\*, (2 dc, ch 5, 2 dc) all in ch-2 sp of next shell; repeat from \* around, end at \*\*; join.

**Rnd 7:** Slip st in next dc and next ch-5 space; ch 4 (counts as 1 tr), 10 tr in ch-5 space, \* ch 3, shell over shell, ch 3 \*\*, 11 tr in next ch-5 space; repeat from \* around, end at \*\*; join in top of ch-4 – 7 tr groups.

**Rnd 8:** Slip st in next tr, ch 5 (counts as 1 tr and ch 1), \* tr in next tr, [ch 1, tr in next tr] 8 times, ch 3, shell over shell, ch 3 \*\*, skip next tr, tr in next tr, ch 1; repeat from \* around, end at \*\*; join to 4th ch of ch-5.

**Rnd 9:** Ch 1, \* sc in next ch-1 space, ch 3, [sc in next ch-1 space, ch 3] 8 times, shell over shell, ch 3; repeat from \* around; join with a slip st in first sc.

**Rnd 10:** Ch 1, \* sc in next ch-3 loop, ch 3, [sc in next ch-3 loop, ch 3] 7 times, shell over shell, ch 3, skip next ch-3 space; repeat from \* around; join. Fasten off.

Now work in rows as follows:

**Row 11:** With right side facing, attach thread in ch-2 space of shell from the previous rnd; (ch 3, ch 2, 2 dc) all in same space, [ch 3, sc in next loop] 7 times, ch 3, shell over shell; turn.

**Row 12:** Ch 3, shell over shell, skip ch-3 space, [ch 3, sc in next loop] 6 times, ch 3, shell over shell; turn.

**Row 13:** Ch 3, shell over shell, skip ch-3 space, [ch 3, sc in next loop] 5 times, ch 3, shell over shell; turn.

**Row 14:** Ch 3, shell over shell, skip ch-3 space, [ch 3, sc in next loop] 4 times, ch 3, shell over shell; turn.

**Row 15:** Ch 3, shell over shell, skip ch-3 space, [ch 3, sc in next loop] 3 times, ch 3, shell over shell; turn.



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**Row 16:** Ch 3, shell over shell, skip ch-3 space, [ch 3, sc in next loop] twice, ch 3, shell over shell; turn.

**Row 17:** Ch 3, shell over shell, ch 4, skip ch-3 space, sc in loop, ch 4, 2 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 1, slip st in ch-2 space of first shell at beginning of Row 17, ch 1, 2 dc in last ch-2 space. Fasten off.

With right side facing, attach thread in same ch-2 space of shell on Rnd 10 where last shell of Row 11 was worked. Repeat Rows 11-17. Continue until all 7 points have been completed.

**Picot Edging-Rnd 1:** With right side facing, attach thread to tip of any point between joined shells; (ch 3, dc, ch 2, 2 dc) all in same space, \* [ch 3, shell in next turning ch] 3 times, ch 2, dc around next dc, dc around next ch-3, ch 2, [shell in next turning ch, ch 3] 3 times \*\*, shell in tip of point between joined shells; repeat from \* around, end at \*\*; join.

**Rnd 2:** Slip st in next dc and in next space; ch 3; ch 5, sc in 5th ch from hook – picot made, dc in same space as slip st, [ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3, (dc, picot, dc) all in ch-2 space of next shell] 3 times, ch 3, sc between next 2 dc, ch 3, (dc, picot, dc) all in ch-2 space of next shell, [ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3, (dc, picot, dc) all in ch-2 space of next shell] 3 times; repeat from \* around working sts in brackets twice instead of 3 times in last repeat; join. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

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**AUNT LYDIA'S® “Bamboo”**, Art. 148 , Size 10 Crochet, available in 300yd (276m) balls.

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**ABBREVIATIONS:** **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **rnd** = round; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch (es); **tr** = treble crochet; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.



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
