

## SEWING PROJECTS

### Snowflake Fleece Pillow

Skill Level: Easy

This snowflake is pretty like the ones that fall outside, but warm & cozy nestled in your favorite chair inside. It is simple to sew an applique onto fleece and our pearlescent Metallic thread makes it sparkle.

#### Supplies:

- Coats Dual Duty XP All-purpose thread- to match fabric
- Coats Metallic Embroidery thread, color 800 pearl
- Fleece Fabric, 2 15" squares
- Fleece Fabric, white 10" square, or large enough to cut snowflake
- Pillow form, 12" square
- Snowflake pattern

**Optional:** Tear-away Stabilizer 10" square

#### Steps:

##### 1. Cutting:

From white fleece, cut out snowflake.

##### 2. Appliqué:

Pin or use a glue stick to place snowflake in the center of one of the fleece squares. Place stabilizer underneath applique area. Thread your machine with Pearl thread on top and all purpose thread on the bobbin. Set machine for a medium width zig zag stitch (3- 4mm wide and a stitch length of 2-3 mm). Zig zag around flake, pivoting at corners. Pull thread ends to the underside and tie. Remove stabilizer.

##### 6. Pillow:

On pillow front, mark a square measuring 2" from the cut edges. Place pillow front on pillow back, **wrong** sides of fabric together. Pin. Thread machine with all-purpose thread. Sew around square, leaving a 6" opening on one side.

##### 4. Finishing:

Insert pillow form. Pin together on marking of open side of square, making sure cut edges are even. Stitch opening, being careful to push pillow form out of the seam line. Backstitch at each end of stitching to secure.
