



Crochet Lacy Snowflakes

Finished size:

Large snowflake = 5¼"/13.5cm diameter

Small snowflake = 4"/10cm diameter

AUNT LYDIA'S® Fashion Crochet Thread, Size 5: 1 ball each 410S Silver/Silver and 210S White/Silver.

AUNT LYDIA'S® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10, 1 ball of 1 White.

Crochet Hooks: Size 4 (2.00mm) steel crochet hook, Size 8 (1.50mm) steel crochet hook.
Fabric stiffener; cardboard; plastic wrap; rustproof pins; plastic bowl; monofilament.

Gauges: Large snowflake Rounds 1–2 = 1¼" diameter using size 4 hook. Small snowflake Rounds 1–2 = 1" diameter using size 8 hook. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hooks to obtain the gauges.**

Note: Use size 4 hook with size 5 thread for large snowflake and size 8 hook with size 10 thread for small snowflake.

SNOWFLAKE (make 8 from each thread)

Ch 5; sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1; *3 sc in ring, ch 5; repeat from * 7 times more – 24 sc and 8 ch-5 lps. Join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: *Sl st in next sc (center sc of 3 sc group), ch 2, work (sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch-5 lp, ch 2, skip next sc; repeat from * around - 16 sc, 8 sl sts and 24 ch-2 sps. Join with sl st in beginning sl st.

Rnd 3: Sl st in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 sc in same ch-2 sp; *[sl st in next ch-2 sp (between 2 sc); ch 14, sl st in 8th ch from hook (picot made); ch 8, sl st in 6th ch from hook (picot made); ch 7, sl st in 7th ch from hook (picot made); ch 6, sl st in 6th ch from hook (picot made); ch 10, sl st in 8th ch from hook (picot made), sl st in same ch as sl st at base of first picot (8th ch of ch-14); ch 6, sl st in same ch-2 sp] spoke made**; (3 sc in next ch-2 sp) twice; repeat from * around, ending final repeat at **; 3 sc in next ch-2 sp - 8 spokes and 48 sc. Join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

FINISHING: Cover cardboard with plastic wrap. Pour small amount of fabric stiffener in plastic bowl. Place snowflake into stiffener, covering entire snowflake, and squeeze out excess. Lay snowflake on covered cardboard, shape, and pin points. Allow to dry. Insert monofilament through ch-lp at top of one point and tie a knot for hanging loop.

AUNT LYDIA'S® Fashion Crochet Thread, Size 5: each ball approx 300yds/273m (cotton/metallic).

AUNT LYDIA'S® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10, each ball approx 400yds/364m (cotton).

ABBREVIATIONS: ch = chain; lp = loop; sc = single crochet; sl st = slip stitch; sp(s) = space(s); * = Repeat directions following * as many times as indicated. [] or () = Work directions in brackets or parentheses into stitch or space indicated.
