

## CD752-06 Ogee, Oh My



Approximate Time to Make: 35 hours

**AFGHAN measures approximately 40" X 58".**

**TLC® "Essentials™"**, Art E514, 100% acrylic, (6 oz/312 yard skein): 3 skeins No. 2101 White **CA**, 5 skeins No. 2820 Robin Egg **CB**, 1 skein No. 2335 Taupe **CC**.

**Option 1: Red Heart® "Super Saver®"**, Art. E300, (7 oz / 364 yard solids and 5 oz / 255 yard multi skeins): 316 Soft White **CB** and 661 Frosty Green **CC**. **Red Heart® "Fiesta®"**, Art. E704, (6 oz / 316 yard skeins): No. 6661 Meadow **CA**.

**Option 2: Red Heart® "Super Saver®"**: 316 Soft White **CA** and 776 Dark Orchid **CC**. **Red Heart® "Fiesta®"**: 6534 Orchid **CB**.

**Crochet Hook:** 6 mm [US J-10].

Yarn needle.

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**GAUGE:** Motif Rnds 1-3 = 4.5" tall x 4" wide.

**CHECK YOUR GAUGE:** Use any size hook to obtain gauge.

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### SPECIAL ABBREVIATION:

**Sc Dec** = (Insert hook in stitch indicated, yo, and pull up a lp) 2 times, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hook.

### Motif: Make 237

With **CA**, ch 4, sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, 6 sc in ring; join with a sl st to first sc - 6 sc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 3, (counts as first dc) 2 dc in same st, [ch 3, 3 dc in next sc] 5 times, ch 3; join with a sl st in top of beg ch-3 - 18 dc, 6 ch-3 sp. Fasten off.

**Rnd 3:** Join **CB** in any ch-3 corner sp; ch 4 (counts as dc plus ch-1), (tr, ch 1, dc) all in same sp, \*dc in next 3 dc, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp, tr in next 3 dc, placing a marker in the middle tr of last 3 tr, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp, dc in next 3 dc,\*\* (dc, ch 1, tr, ch 1, dc) all in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* one more time,

ending at \*\*; join with a sl st in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beg ch-4 - 40 sts. Fasten off.

**PLACEMENT:** Line up the motifs in 19 strips of 12 and 13 motifs alternately, off setting the motifs so that the top of the second motif is adjacent to the middle (marked) tr of a side of the first motif.

**ASSEMBLY:** Beg at the bottom most point of row one, join **CC** in the middle tr, ch 1, sc in same st, ch 3, sc in same st, working in **back loop only**, sl st ch-1 sp and next 8 sts on first motif, remove marker, sl st in the back loop of the tr on first motif and the outer loop of the middle tr point on the motif to its side, sl st the two motifs together using the outer loops for the next 9 sts, when three motifs come together, sl st through all three. Continue to sl st in the outer loops of both motifs, keeping the point of one motif at the middle tr on the side of the adjacent motif. Allow the sl sts to follow the contours of the motifs. After completing a (sc, ch 3, sc) in a middle tr point, continue to sl st along the opposite side and join another row.

**EDGING:** Edging is worked down the two long sides only as follows:

**Row 1:** With RS facing, join **CB** in first ch-3 sp, ch 1, sc in **back loop only** of each st. When you come to a joining of two motifs, sc dec, working the first half of the st on one motif, and the second half of the st on the second motif. Repeat for other long side. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
